

Dr. Sombo Muzata is an Assistant Professor of Political Science at James Madison University. She is Co-Director of the Master of Public Administration (MPA) program, in the Department of Political Science in the College of Arts and Letters. Dr. Muzata is a multi-disciplinary expert whose research interests lie at the intersection of government and business. She is passionate about accountability in government and is the convener of the Accountability in African Public Policy and Administration conference, an annual conference of academics and practitioners, that advances scholarship and its link to practice.
